

Taking pictures of your horse for remote saddle fit and conformation check

If possible use a level, flat, hard surface.



If possible keep the horse straight  
for these two pictures

Take this picture below before **AND** after riding - include trot, canter and some down-hill work (if you have hills) - note there is no numnah. Before riding shows the saddle position you choose at saddling-up and after riding shows where the saddle settles. So take the picture of what happens and not what you think should happen



Sweat mark pictures after riding - these were generated with a 1 hr ride on a warm day at walk, trot and canter. It may not be possible to reproduce exactly but do the best you can. Riding without a numnah does usually leave a useful impression.
