



Saddles just did not fit Shannon - a wide horse with an even wider rib cage and a girth groove into the arm pits. Saddles slide forward over the shoulder or greatly restricted Shannon's movement making her a groutchy horse to ride

The *FuE* saddle and the *FuE*T-Girth did the trick.

Denise Parker and Shannon can now do Endurance, Dressage and Jumping, the saddle stays behind the shoulder allowing front leg freedom. The riding teacher likes it too!

## A Saddle Fitting Challenge T-Girth Fixes the Problem!

This horse's conformation is very difficult to fit but the T-girth uses the forces between saddle and horse so that the saddle stays in place without blocking the shoulders.
